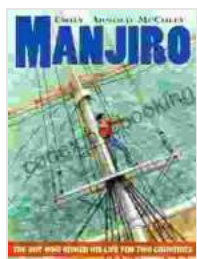


# The Boy Who Risked His Life For Two Countries

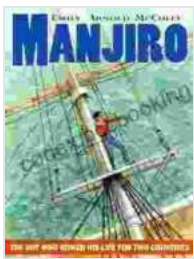
next, but he refused to leave them behind. Instead, he marched with them to the Umschlagplatz, the deportation point, and boarded the train that would take them to Treblinka.

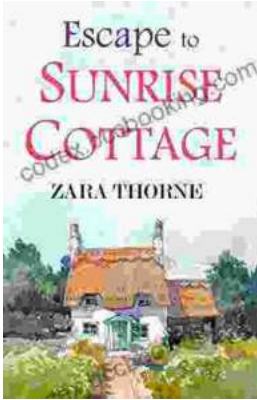

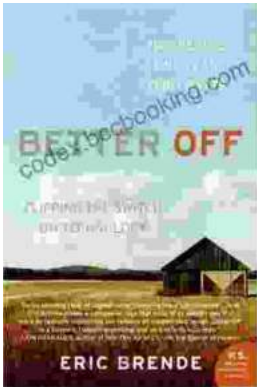
